# HOW CAN I BECOME INVOLVED IN THE SCHOOL COMMUNITY AT STROTHOFF?

Parent involvement is an asset to our community! There are numerous ways and opportunities for you to volunteer:

#### 1. Become involved with the PTO.

All parents and teachers are members of the PTO. This allows them to attend all PTO meetings. At the first PTO meeting at the beginning of the school year, the PTO board is elected.

### 2. Volunteer to help with events.

The PTO is always organizing, planning or conducting activities or events. The PTO is always looking for volunteers to ensure success.

### 3. Become a class parent representative.

Class parent representatives are an important source of help and support that benefits all students. There are 1-2 positions for each class in KG through PYP4. Parent volunteers are welcome to support the school by helping in the home language classrooms at the PYP level and in the libraries with activities such as reading to the children and field trips.

## 4. Help with after school activities (ASA).

Many parents enjoy helping out with after school activities (ASA). Inform your child's teacher of how you can help during the school year.
