

SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY AND CLOTHES LIST for Diploma Students

It is our expectation that every student is neatly turned out in a clean and full school uniform. **A student who is unsuitably dressed may be asked to return home to change clothing.**

Diploma Programme students have off-campus privileges and every Diploma Programme student is issued with with an **ID card**. The ID card has an important function: it their personal identification when on campus and indicates when they are off campus (important for safety procedures, etc.) Aligned with the off-campus privileges and ID badges are **certain uniform concessions**.

Diploma Programme students **must** wear their ID badge when in school and return it to the magnetic board at the reception, when leaving the building.

Strothoff International School hooded sweat jacket	Dark blue with school logo. DP alternative: a solid colour (black, dark blue or grey) plain sweat jacket. No alternative logo is permitted.
Strothoff International School pullover, sweatshirt	V-necked long sleeved or sleeveless, dark blue with school logo. DP alternative: a solid colour (black, dark blue or grey) plain pullover or sweatshirt.
Strothoff International School shirt or polo	White or light blue with school logo. DP alternative: plain white or light blue polo or shirt with collar.
Trousers / shorts	Plain single colour: dark blue, grey or black.
Scarves	Plain, single colour, dark blue, black, grey or red
Belt	Plain single colour, dark blue, black or brown
Socks	Plain single colour, dark blue, black or white
Shoes	Predominantly a single colour dark blue, black or brown. In winter, students may wear warm winter shoes (dark blue, black or brown).

SPORT CLOTHING: DP BOYS

Strothoff International School polo shirt (white) or T-shirt in House colours,
 Dark blue or black sport shorts (maximum knee-length),
 Dark blue, black or white socks,
 Indoor training shoes with non marking soles (only to be worn in the gymnasium),
 Outdoor training shoes.

For all activities in the gymnasium the only acceptable footwear is clean indoor training shoes. These regulations apply equally to after school activities and voluntary recreational sessions.

Strothoff International School hooded sweat jacket.	Dark blue with school logo. DP alternative: a solid colour (black, dark blue or grey) plain sweat jacket. No alternative logo is permitted.
Strothoff International School pullover or sweatshirt.	V-necked long sleeved or sleeveless, dark blue with school logo. DP alternative: a solid colour (black, dark blue or grey) plain pullover or sweatshirt.
Strothoff International School blouse or polo	White or light blue with school logo. DP alternative: plain white or light blue polo or shirt with collar.
Trousers / shorts	Plain single colour, dark blue, grey or black.
Skirt	Plain, dark blue, grey or black, no shorter than one hand above knee.
Scarves	Plain, single colour, dark blue, black, grey or red
Belt	Plain, single colour, dark blue, black or brown
Socks	Plain, single colour, dark blue, black or white
Tights	Plain, single colour, dark blue or natural color

Strothoff International School polo shirt (white) or T-shirt in House colours,
Dark blue or black sport shorts (maximum knee-length),
Dark blue, black or white socks,
Indoor training shoes with non marking soles (only to be worn in the gymnasium),
Outdoor training shoes.

For all activities in the gymnasium the only acceptable footwear is clean indoor training shoes. These regulations apply equally to after school activities and voluntary recreational sessions.

HAIR, JEWELLERY, MAKEUP AND HEAD COVERINGS

Hair - Hair must be kept clean, neat and tidy. Hair must be tied during sport lessons or on request of any teacher due to hygiene or safety reasons. Hair should not be visibly dyed or bleached; dramatic haircuts and use of colorants are not acceptable.

Jewellery and makeup – one discreet ring, one discrete bracelet, small stud earrings and a plain, simple necklace with a small pendant are acceptable, no other jewellery is allowed. Only discreet makeup is allowed.

Head coverings – Head coverings required to be worn for cultural or religious reasons are acceptable, as long as they do not interfere with the educational process, do not pose a safety risk (e.g. in PHE or Science), and do not cover any part of the face. If in doubt, please contact the Head of School or relevant Principal.

RESPONSIBILITIES

All belongings must be in good repair and clearly and indelibly named. All clothes must be marked (with name tapes and/or laundry pen). All other items, including personal effects, must also be clearly and indelibly marked.

Students must wear the full school uniform at all times, including to and dismissal from school. Students not in uniform will not be allowed to participate in classroom, field trips and/or extracurricular activities – exceptions to this rule are within the discretion of the Principal or Head of School. Permission must be given by the Principal for students to change from the school uniform after school. This will only be given for special reasons and must be requested by the parent.

SIS school pullover, sweatshirt	V-necked long sleeved or sleeveless, dark blue with school logo
SIS school blouse or polo	White or light blue with school logo.
Trousers	Plain single color, dark blue or black. In summer: plain single color, dark blue or black shorts are permitted
Skirt	Plain, dark blue or black, one hand above knee long
Belt	Plain, single color, dark blue, black or brown
Socks	Plain, single color, dark blue, black or white
Tights	Plain, single color, dark blue or natural color
Shoes	Plain single color dark blue, black or brown. Shoes must not have buckles, colored stitching, colored laces, eyelets or any other adornment, nor may they have an extravagant style. Belt	Plain, dark blue, black or brown
Socks or tights	Dark blue, sky blue, black or white
Shoes	Dark indoor Shoes of one solid color (NO boots, runners or shoes above the ankle are permitted in the classroom) According to the weather and time of the year students may arrive in appropriate shoes but have to change upon arrival in school. No extravagant style is permitted.

Belt	Plain, dark blue or black
Socks	Dark blue, sky blue or white
Shoes	Dark indoor shoes of one solid color (NO boots, runners or shoes above the ankle are permitted in the classroom) According to the weather and time of the year students may arrive in appropriate shoes but have to change upon arrival in school. No extravagant style is permitted.

Younger students should bring an extra set of pants/trousers and keep these in a bag on their peg.
